**INTERIM ORDER
GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART DEBTOR'S
EXPEDITED MOTION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 105 AUTHORIZING
PAYMENT OF PRE-PETITION CLAIMS OF CRITICAL TRADE CREDITORS**

This matter comes before the Court upon Debtor's Expedited Motion for Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105 Authorizing Payment of Pre-petition Claims of Critical Trade Creditors (the "Motion"), filed December 4th, 2017 [Doc. No. 14]. A hearing was held on Wednesday, December 6th, 2017 where in Proposed Counsel for Debtor represented that the Bank of Kremlin and Internal Revenue Service had no objections to the Motion. The Office of the United States

Trustee appeared and represented no objections to the Motion. Witnesses were sworn and testimony was heard. Based on the testimony at the hearing and for cause shown in the Motion, the Court finds that the Motion should be granted in part and denied in part.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to pay the pre-petition claims of Ontrack Staffing, Hirecall, A1 Staffing, and Rich and Cartmill.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Debtor's request to pay pre-petition trade claims for all other vendors contained on the critical vendor list attached to the Motion is denied without prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Final Hearing on this interim order, if necessary, is set for Wednesday, January 3rd, 2018, at 9:00AM before The Honorable Chief Judge Janice Loyd, 215 Dean A. McGee Ave, 2nd Floor Courtroom, Oklahoma City, OK 73102.

All findings of fact are based upon representation of Debtor's proposed counsel, Jason A. Sansone.
