FINAL ORDER
GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART DEBTOR’S
EXPEDITED MOTION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 105 AUTHORIZING
PAYMENT OF PRE-PETITION CLAIMS OF CRITICAL TRADE CREDITORS

This matter comes before the Court upon Debtor’s Expedited Motion for Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105 Authorizing Payment of Pre-petition Claims of Critical Trade Creditors (the “Motion”), filed December 4th, 2017 [Doc. No. 14]. A hearing was held on Wednesday, January 3rd, 2018 where in Counsel for Debtor represented that the Bank of Kremlin and Internal Revenue Service had no objections to the Motion. The Office of the United States Trustee

appeared. Witnesses were sworn and testimony was heard. Based on the testimony at the hearing and for cause shown in the Motion, the Court finds that the Motion should be granted in part and denied in part.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to pay the pre-petition claims of Ontrack Staffing, Hirecall, A1 Staffing, and Rich and Cartmill as previously ordered by this Court in the Interim Order entered on December 6th, 2017 [Doc. No. 32].

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to pay the pre-petition claims of EarthSmart Controls and M&M Insulation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to pay the pre-petition claims of Allied Services up to \$3,500.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to pay the pre-petition claims of Ferguson Enterprises up to \$1,566.28.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Debtor's request to pay pre-petition trade claims for all other vendors contained on the critical vendor list attached to the Motion is denied without prejudice. Further, payment of any pre-petition claims contained and authorized in this Order shall be permitted, but not required, of the Debtor and should be done in Debtor's best discretion.

All findings of fact are based upon representation of Debtor's counsel, Jason A. Sansone.
